Chapter 8 – Purpose of Communion



Communion is about connection through relationship; connecting with God and connecting with others. Communion through relationship is going to look unique for each one of us; how or where God speaks to you may be different from your spouse, likewise, how you relate to your family and friends may look different from your neighbor. The important thing is to discover how you connect, so that you can connect. The way God often connects with me outside of focused prayer is when I am doing one of three things; folding laundry, working out, or showering. When I do any one of these three things, I try and keep a journal handy, so I can write down what He impresses upon me. I tend to connect best with my husband and others when we are having a one-on-one focused conversation. Discovering this helps me be more intentional about connecting through communion with God and others.
